The proposal under consideration on this file relates to filling up of a post of Member, Technical, IPAB. On 20.10.2005, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi while hearing a Writ Petition filed by CMTE Development Limited, directed that the Central Government should appoint the Technical Member, IPAB within one month and the post of Technical Member (Patents) be filled up within 3 months.

With a view to meet the deadline fixed for appointment of Technical Member, IPAB, the name recommended by the Selection Committee earlier (which could not be referred to ACC for approval for want of verification report of the character and antecedents of the candidate), was cancelled and approval for appointment of next candidate in panel, Smt. Malati J. Jhaveri as Technical Member (Trade Marks), IPAB was obtained from C&IM. A proposal for appointment of Smt. Malati J. Jhaveri as Member Technical (Trade Marks) was sent to DoPT for approval of ACC with the request to get the approval before the deadline fixed by the Hon'ble Court. The ACC, however, approved the candidature of Shri Syed Obaidur Rahaman and directed that the appointment letter be issued after obtaining the antecedent verification certificate. In view of the ACC's approval of Shri Obaidur Rahaman's candidature for the post of Member Technical, IPAB, the DM South-24 Parganas, Government of West Bengal was requested to get police verification done expeditiously. CGPDTM, Mumbai was also requested to depute official to liaison with the police authorities of Government of West Bengal. The police authorities have since submitted the verification report. The antecedents of Shri Rahaman have been verified with nothing-adverse coming to light. However, the educational qualifications of Shri Rahaman have been verified partly and the remaining of his studies (B. Sc., B.A. and LLB) could not be verified for want of relevant marksheets. In the circumstances, this Department is not in a position to meet the deadline fixed for filling the post of Member Technical (Trade Marks) even within the extended deadline i.e., before 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2006 fixed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.

Shri Ashok Bhasin, Senior Government Counsel has informed that the petitioner has filed a writ against the registration of Trade Marks "Bonny" in the name of Bonny Care Pvt Ltd. under Trade Marks Act. The petitioner's application for removal of Trade Marks before the Intellectual Property Appellate Board (IPAB) is pending but the IPAB is not functioning. The matter was listed before the Court on 18.1.2006 when the Government Counsel appeared on behalf of Govt of India. During the course of argument, the Hon'ble Court informed that in another matter, the Court has directed that the IPAB shall be constituted and functions within 6 months. The Court further directed the Govt Counsel to enquire from the concerned Department whether the IPAB has been constituted or have started functioning or not within 10 days. The matter was listed again for 25.1.2006. However, no reply was received from the Department with regard to functioning of Appellate Tribunal. The Hon'ble Court in the WP No. 13034 of 2005 had granted two months' time lapsing on 20.1.2006 to appoint Technical Member (Trade Marks). The Hon'ble Court in the present matter had directed if the Appellate Tribunal have not started functioning from 20.1.2006 then on the next date of hearing i.e., 31.1.2006, the Secretary of the concerned Ministry shall remain present before the Court.

It is stated that this Department has come to know only through the letter of Shri Ashok Bhasin, Senior Government Counsel (dated 25.1.2006 received today) about the filing of a WP by M/s. Paul Manufacturing against the non-functioning of IPAB.

The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi has earlier directed to appoint Technical Member (Trade Marks) within one month and Technical Member (Patents) within three months to the IPAB, Chennai vide its order dated 20.10.2005 passed in WT No. 13034 of 2005 – CMTE Development Ltd Vs. Union of India and Others. On a request filed by this Department, the Hon'ble Court vide its order dated 20.12.2005 allowed two months extension for filling up the post of Technical Member (Patents). While approval of the Cabinet has been obtained for the creation of a post of Technical Member (Patents) the advertisement for inviting application for the post will be published on 30.1.2006. The post of Technical Member (Trade marks) could not be filled up as educational credentials of the selected candidate could not be verified despite best of efforts.

Despite the earnest efforts of this Department and day-to-day monitoring at the level of Joint Secretary, filling up the vacancies of Technical Members in the IPAB, Chennai is taking time on account of reasons beyond the control of this Department. Consequently, a request for further extension of four months' time for filling up the post of Technical Member in the IPAB has been filed in the form of an application before the Hon'ble Court on 20.1.2006. The Senior Government Counsel, Shri J.P. Singh who has filed the application, has however

requested for engaging Additional Solicitor General for the application seeking extension of time. Shri J.P. Singh was apprised of WP No. 723 of 2006 today and he reiterated engagement of ASG. The ACC further directed that order would be issued after obtaining the antecedents verification certificate (p.185/cor). The Office of the District Magistrate, South 24 Parganas, Kolkata has intimated vide letter dated 5.1.06 (pp.204/cor.) that there is no adverse report against the candidate in South 24 Parganas and Kolkata District. It is further stated by the District Magistrate, "He is an Indian National and part of study (M.P.) has been verified but the remaining portion of studies (B.Sc., B.A., and LL.B.) could not be verified for want of relevant marksheets, as per police report." In a case filed by CMTE Development Ltd against the Controller of Patents and others concerning the orders issued by the Patent Office in an application for Patents, the issue of operationalisation of IPAB in respect of Patent Law for which the provision was made in the Patent Act by an amendment to the said Act in June, 2002 was raised by the Petitioner before the Delhi High Court on 20.10.2005. 
