Ms. Jayashree Watal is Counsellor in the Intellectual Property Division of the World Trade Organization (from February 2001). Ms. Watal holds post-graduate degrees in both Law (University of Paris, France) and Economics (Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics, Pune, India) and has more than twenty two years of experience in government in India, of which ten years was devoted to policy, diplomacy, research and administration on intellectual property rights. She worked in the Government of India, Ministry of Commerce as Director in the Trade Policy Division, New Delhi (1995-1998). She represented India at a crucial stage in the Uruguay Round TRIPS negotiations from 1989-90.
