03.08.2023, which it is submitted is clarificatory in nature, keeping in view of the object and purpose and the intent behind the enactment.

The appellant - DCM Shriram Limited will maintain records and accounts of the sales. They will file monthly statement of sales and accounts with the authorities.

Till the next date of hearing, there shall be stay of the directions given in impugned judgment/order to make payment/deposit of 0.5% levy in terms of the BD Act. The appellant - DCM Shriram Limited, however, will not be entitled to seek refund of the amount already deposited.

No coercive steps including prosecution will be initiated by the authorities.
