1. After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would seek instructions and file additional documents and additional affidavit giving clearer instances of alleged irregularities in the main examination.

2. It is to be noted that some of the petitioners claim to have participated in the main examination and have not been successful. It is consequent upon not clearing the examination, the said challenge has been made before this Court alleging various irregularities. There is no document placed on record to show any irregularity at all in the



first place. Moreover, the disposal of the representation by the respondent which was directed to be *vide* order dated 13.03.2024 in W.P.(C) 3732/2024 comprised of some petitioners who are part of this petition. However, it is reflected as if all of them were participants in the previous round of litigation. It is clear that all of the petitioners were not part of the earlier litigation.

3. That apart, Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Ashok Kumar and Another vs. State of Bihar and Others* reported in (2017) 4 SCC 357 categorically held that those of the candidates who participated in the examination and are unsuccessful cannot be heard to challenge the process of the examination subsequently.

4. As the petitioners seek one opportunity to place on record better documents and an additional affidavit, one opportunity is still granted despite the odds against the petitioners.

5. The said documents, if any, and additional affidavit be filed within three weeks from today with advance copy to the learned counsel for the respondent.

6. List for admission again on 15.07.2024.
